


August Pets of the Month By Megan Gabel and Jayn Corral

A Plea for Serinidad and Aluxe

All they want is a nice family, a quiet comfortable spot, some food and love. They aren't asking for much and don't require any special care. They are unlikely to cause you any problems. Instead they will give you much more in return. They just are not happy living with so many other cats at the S.P.A. Please dig into your hearts and consider giving them the home they so badly need and deserve.

Serinidad, an aptly named lovely black and white sweetheart, arrived at the S.P.A. in late 2017 at the age of one year and pregnant. She was a dutiful mom and soon her kids were adopted, leaving her at the S.P.A. with lots of other cats that sometimes bully her without provocation.

She loves visits by volunteers and will place her paws on their shoulders asking for a hug and some special time together. She divides her time between a sunny spot and a small, safe dark spot for sleeping. She tolerates her life at the S.PA., but she wants desperately to have her own space and loving family..

Aluxe, a gorgeous sweet tabby girl, has lived at the S.P.A. since April 2018 when she was just one week old. She not only had a mother and siblings, but she had *two* mothers, siblings and cousins. The two moms took turns caring for their six babies. The moms, siblings and cousins have since been adopted, although one sister, Xel-Ha, is still living happily at the S.P.A.

But Aluxe is never seen moving from her one spot. She won't move and refuses to let anyone move her. After examining her, the veterinarian assured us that she is in good health, not losing weight, and that she is eating and using the litter box when people cannot see her. Aluxe will share her space with other cats or kittens and welcomes petting by volunteers. It breaks our hearts to see her live such a reclusive, sad life. She needs a place to call her own where she can feel safe, loved and brave enough to move about.

Zeus, Lola, and Dulce do not like strangers and they are not reticent about letting you know their



feelings. When potential adopters meet them, these dogs are usually not very friendly – in fact, they react quite vocally to newcomers. On the street, Zeus is the easiest to walk, not typically bothered by strangers. He keeps his head down, moves forward, and occasionally turns around for reassurance from the person walking him. When taking Dulce and Lola for a walk on the street, it is best to avoid people they don't know; for Dulce, stay clear of cars and motorcycles too.

So, why should you bother considering any of them as a pet for you? Because what you will ultimately get in return will be a real gem.





To the volunteers who work with them, Zeus, Lola, and Dulce are each incredibly adorable, affectionate, and sweet dogs. Dulce will lie quietly at my side, occasionally glancing in my direction to make sure I'm okay. Staring directly into my eyes adoringly, Lola will shift from paw to paw, excited to receive attention. Zeus will climb into my lap and nestle in for a hug, always eager for more affection which I'm happy to give.

If you give them a chance, these dogs will be devoted to you, extremely loyal, and very protective. But you have to earn their trust. You have to give them time to get to know you and you to know them. You have to be a smart owner – reactive – perceptive – alert. Consider it a challenge, but one that is well worth the effort. You will be rewarded with a dog who will love you wholeheartedly and protect you against actual and perceived danger – a warning system, no batteries necessary. Perfect loving pets, particularly for a man or woman alone who could use the extra security.

Cat Talk By Jayn Corral

Have you ever found yourself having conversations with cats, wondering what they are really saying? I have had cats all my adult life and now with over 30 cat pals at the S.P.A., I often catch myself having sustained exchanges with cats. "What? What do you want?" "No, we already had treats." "OK, I'll get you more water." "I'm sorry I sneezed and woke you up."

After birds, cats have the widest range of vocals. There are the good sounds, like purring. Experts still don't understand how it is that cats produce their purring sounds, which is a soft, deep throaty rumble that often causes their bodies to vibrate. Generally, purring indicates the cat is in the best of moods, feeling safe, happy or sleepy. "Meow" is another good sound that cats make. Interestingly, cats meow primarily to humans and not to other cats. They are saying, "Hi, thanks for coming," or "Hey, you, listen to me, I want something." Beware though, if your cat is purring or meowing often and incessantly; that could be a sign of pain or illness and you may want to consider a visit to the veterinarian.

And then there are distress sounds like hissing. Hissing sounds like a sizzling steak on the grill and is a defensive tactic when a cat feels threatened, fear or dissatisfaction. The cat will open its mouth, flatten its ears, puff and twitch its tail to appear larger and more threatening to the source of danger.

Some experts purport that breed determines how much a cat will vocalize. For example, Siamese cats tend to talk more than Persians; short-haired cats are less talkative than their long-haired counterparts. But there are always individual exceptions.

There are many other cat sounds, like chirping, crying and whining, chatter trills, snarls and growls. Combined with learning how to read cats' body language, we can tell a lot about what is on cats' minds by the sounds they make.

The language of cat talk is very complex, nuanced by the importance of the message. Understanding cat talk will help you understand and better communicate with your cat and a cat you might be thinking about adopting. Come to the S.P.A., Los Pinos 7, Monday-Saturday, 11-2, and get involved with a conversation with Chili, Olivia, Larissa, Sassy, and other S.P.A. cats available for adoption. Our adoption fee is only 500 pesos and includes all current vaccinations, deworming, a feline leukemia test, and sterilization.
