# **From the Director**

Adoptions

We are thrilled to announce that thanks to a matching grant from San Miguel Community Foundation, our clinic is now equipped with a digital x-ray system. This is a major improvement to our ability to diagnose injuries and illnesses suffered by our clinic patients and our own resident animals.

Let me give you a little background. Thanks to a 2015 grant from SMCF, the S.P.A. owns an x-ray generator, but it required chemicals to work (developer and fixer) as well as film. Recently, when it came time to order new supplies, we discovered they weren't available. Not in Mexico. Not in the U.S. to ship to Mexico.

We investigated options and learned the generator we had could be converted to a digital system. We had to find a Mexican supplier who could provide what we needed at a reasonable price. We were also faced with arranging the space in our small clinic to accommodate the new system which also required a specialized separate table. Below is a photo of the results!







# **Our Daily Supplies Always Need Replenishing**

The items below are supplies we replace on a regular basis. Please drop off donations at the S.P.A. during our regular office hours.

- •Batteries (AA)
- •Brooms
- •Cat baskets for kittens/cats to sleep in
- •Cat food—Felix canned
- •Cat food—Royal Canin Development for cats (soft & dry)
- •Cat food—Royal Canin Gastrointestinal for cats (soft & dry)
- •Cat food—Royal Canin Babycat Milk (dry powdered milk for kittens)
- •Cat food platters (plastic, divided, circular trays)
- •Cat litter (we use Petco bulk litter)
- •Cat /kitten toys
- •Cat scoops for litter
- •Cat treats: catnip and other treats
- •Cats: Feliway Spray and Feliway Diffuser
- •Cleaning supplies: dishwashing soap, bleach, pinol or equivalent
- •Dog collars (medium-sized)
- •Dog leashes (1" wide)
- •Dog food—Pedigree canned adult dog food and puppy food
