From the Director

The S.P.A., San Miguel's only no-kill shelter for dogs and cats, houses a combined average of 100 animals and often has more in foster homes. Last year, almost 100 cats and dogs were adopted from us.

This year's goal is \$250,000 pesos (about \$13,500 USD. Please help us feed our Hungry Dogs and Hungry Cats by making a monetary deposit to our Pet Food Money Bank. Because animals do not adjust well to changes in diet and we lack sufficient storage space, we need to raise money to apply to the annual cost of feeding them the food they are accustomed to eating, rather than seek donations of food. What is “SPA Dogs to DC”?

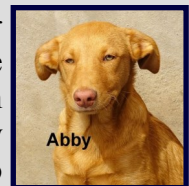
In 2018, dog adoptions at the S.P.A. had decreased dramatically. Our cages were overflowing with dogs so much so that we exploded into our reserved isolation cages for our regular resident dogs. In 2019, the S.P.A. and our wonderful volunteer, Tammy Belden, partnered in a project called “SPA Dogs to DC” to work towards resolving this situation by transporting S.P.A. dogs to the States to find homes that were simply unavailable here.

When Tammy took her first load of 5 SPA dogs to DC in April 2019, we were able to move dogs from isolation into regular cages so that we and our volunteers could easily interact with them and they could be exposed to the public. After Tammy’s second 2019 trip in August, we were finally able to take in dogs from our waiting list, the first time in more than a year. We then turned our focus to include dogs who are likely doomed to die at Ecologia, San Miguel’s kill pound. We routinely visit the pound and, when we have space, test some dogs to make sure they are healthy, and then bring them to the S.P.A. In recent months, we have saved 10 dogs from certain death as a result of this effort. Seven of them have already been adopted.

So far, SPA Dogs to DC has resulted in 16 adoptions of S.P.A. dogs in the States. Macarena, Mia, Tigi, Gigi, Isabella, Cocoa, Holly, Skye, Fresa, Simba, Maple, Snowflake, Mocha, Latte, Stella, and Dipper are all in loving homes thanks to the joint efforts of the S.P.A. and our relentless volunteer, Tammy Belden.



In the last two trips, thanks to the sponsorship of S.P.A. volunteer Teenie Gibson, S.P.A. puppies Honey, Sparkle, Abby, and Sophie hitched a ride with Tammy to the border. Their ultimate destination was a Canadian shelter. In each instance, the puppies were rapidly adopted and moved from the Canadian shelter’s foster situation to permanent loving homes.



At least 5 more dogs, some of them long-term residents, are on the list for the next trip, as soon as travel restrictions are lifted.

Cassidy

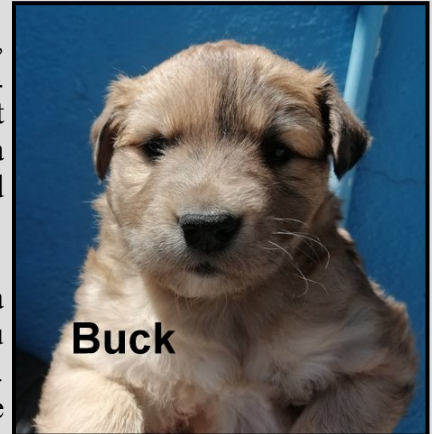
Butch and his sister, Cassidy, are a little over 4 months old. Butch is energetic, alert, and confident. Cassidy is self-assured and inquisitive.

Please keep 6 feet away from our personnel at all times.

Feline Leukemia Warning - Please Be Careful!

We fear that feline leukemia is rampant in San Miguel. In the last couple of months, the S.P.A. has taken in 12 cats, all of which have tested positive for feline leukemia and based upon S.P.A. protocol, have had to be euthanized. The test we use is the best available.

The feline leukemia virus is one of the most common infectious diseases in cats. It is shed in the saliva, nasal secretions, urine, feces, and milk of infected cats. The disease only affects cats—it cannot be transmitted to people, dogs, or other animals. During the disease's early stages, infected cats usually do not exhibit any signs of the disease at all.

All S.P.A. cats are tested for feline leukemia and, if negative, are vaccinated for feline leukemia. S.P.A. kittens less than 12 weeks old are segregated from the remaining population until they are old enough to be tested for feline leukemia (at least 12 weeks old).

If you adopt or take in a cat from anywhere other than the S.P.A., please make sure that you get that cat tested for feline leukemia and, if that cat is negative, vaccinate that cat for feline leukemia. If the cat tests positive, since the cat is yours, it is up to you how to handle it. You are not required to euthanize that cat, but, if you don't, you must keep the cat away from ALL other cats FOREVER so that it does not spread the disease. The median survival time for cats after the virus is diagnosed is 2.5 years. There is no cure or treatment for feline leukemia.

The S.P.A. is open for adoptions as long as certain precautions are followed. Our adoption hours are Monday-Saturday, 11-2, Los Pinos 7, 415-152-6124. Our available cats like Larissa are here: <https://www.spasanmiguel.org/adopt-me-cats/> Our available dogs like Missy are here: <https://www.spasanmiguel.org/adopt-me-dogs/> Our adoption fee is 500 pesos. For cats, the fee includes sterilization, all current vaccinations, deworming, the feline leukemia/FIV test, and the feline leukemia vaccine and booster. For dogs, it includes sterilization, all current vaccinations, deworming, the leptospirosis booster, and enrollment in the Green Paw Pet Registration Program.

If you come to the S.P.A. with family or friends, only one person will be allowed to enter the S.P.A. to be interviewed for an adoption of a cat or dog. That person must wear a mask and stay at least 6 feet (2 meters) away from S.P.A. personnel. We strongly believe that it is worth the effort to end up with a new loving member of your family to keep you company during these difficult times!

The S.P.A.'s clinic is open! The S.P.A. can meet your pet's needs, from routine preventative care to diagnosis and treatment of problems to surgical procedures and more. We have a well-equipped clinic and offer packages to help you save on vaccinations and sterilization. Under the current circumstances, we prefer that no one enters the clinic other than S.P.A. personnel. If critical, only 1 person may enter the S.P.A. with his animal and that person must wear a mask and stay 6 feet (2 meters) away from S.P.A. personnel. Thank you for your consideration in following these rules.

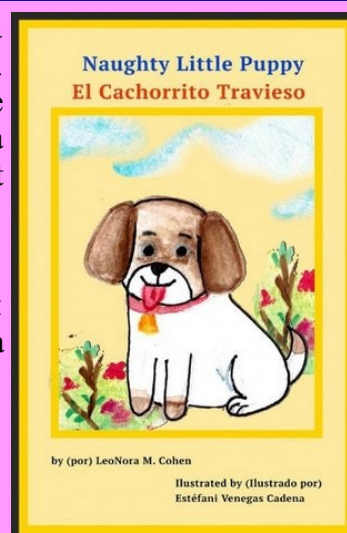
