Happy 2022! We join you in hoping for a better, safer, easier year. We're all ready to put the pandemic behind us, but apparently it's not time yet.

Thank you for all your help during 2021! We appreciate your support (and need it!). We ended the year with some very good news—we were able to take full advantage of the offer from anonymous donors to match new donations through December 31 up to a total of \$2,500!

Because of you, we are able to provide food, care, and shelter for an average of 100 animals (combined total of cats and dogs) while they wait to be adopted. We are hopeful that as 2022 progresses, it will be possible to invite you back as volunteers. Volunteers help socialize our animals and minimize their fear of strangers, making it easier for them to adjust to a new family. We miss you!

Please take advantage of our clinic services for your pets. The S.P.A.'s on-site clinic and our full-time veterinarian, Dr. Omar Córdova, offer lower-cost, high-quality health care for your pets. Tuesdays and Thursdays are discount days at the S.P.A.'s clinic. We stay open later (until 4) and the vet's consultation fee plus most vaccinations are reduced on those days.

We also have packages to reduce the cost for providing full protection for your cherished cats and dogs. Please see our website HERE for details about what the various packages include.

For cats, the kit includes a tote bag, temporary litter box, litter, scoop, starter food, and instructions.

After I finish feeding them and cleaning up afterwards, I look forward to bonding with the cats, helping to socialize them, and time for personal reflection as I sit with them in peace. We are friends and have grown to understand each other. The other day I was reminded that it is good to talk to our animals, although I knew this intuitively and quite often engage them in conversation. Of course, I do most of the talking. I was telling them how excited I am about my upcoming trip to visit my mother and siblings after nearly two years of emails and zoom calls. I told them that I will be with my mom on her 94th birthday and we will have plenty of time to catch up. I was thinking about the new year fast approaching, the upcoming holidays, and, just in general, feeling grateful, happy, and optimistic.

I was sitting with Eva on my lap, her eyes closed as she luxuriated in my gentle massage when it struck me. Eva came to the S.P.A. at nearly two-years-old in April 2021, mad at everything and everyone. I was extremely worried about her not being able to exist in a shelter environment. She was bossy and angry. We had no choice but to isolate her so that no one would get hurt. Touch her the wrong way and you would be sorry. "Don't mess with Eva," was her message, loud and clear. Sometimes a pet on the head would be acceptable, other times not. She didn't appear to be a candidate for adoption; however, she was miserable with her shelter life.

Little by little, we introduced her to the other cats and volunteers. Ever so slowly, she relaxed and stopped being so bossy with the other cats. Ever so slowly, she accepted more pets than not, and her bites were softer. Recently she began to stretch up to sit on the volunteers' shoulders, but petting was still forbidden. Now, here today, she is sitting on my lap enjoying our time together. We are both grateful that we put forth the effort to become friends and to be happy. What an amazing transformation for this amazing girl!

As we welcome the new year, the S.P.A. cats and I send our appreciation to all of you who have supported the S.P.A. throughout the years. Please know that your support has saved and enhanced the lives of many cats and dogs in San Miguel.







That person must wear a mask and stay at least 6 feet (2 meters) away from S.P.A. personnel. Adoption hours are Monday-Saturday, 11-2.

*Come to the S.P.A.'s table at the Organic Market – Saturday, January 8, 2022 at Ancha de San Antonio 123, from 9 to 3:30 (lower level, turn right).
