The Sociedad Protectora de Animales de San Miguel de Allende, A. C. is the oldest no-kill shelter for cats and dogs in San Miguel de Allende. We have been providing food, shelter, and care for unwanted and abandoned animals since 1980. Our goal has always been to find permanent, loving homes for our cats and dogs. We have an on-site clinic that provides veterinary services for our own animals and those belonging to the public. Without donations from our supporters, the S.P.A., a non-profit organization, could not exist.

What does "no-kill" mean at the S.P.A.? Barring unusual circumstances, it means that we are committed to providing food, care, and shelter for our resident animals no matter how long it takes to find them forever homes, even If they never get adopted.



Examples of our commitment to them are evident in the photos above showing some of the dogs as babies and how they look now, after spending their lives (so far) at the S.P.A. Then there is Martin who arrived as a kitten in 2009 and Vanderbilt, only 1 year old when he was given refuge at the S.P.A. in 2017. Although we find it hard to believe that no one has fully appreciated their uniqueness, the good news is that we know that all of our cats and dogs, no matter how long they have been at the S.P.A., are happy. We strive to meet all their needs on a daily basis and give them lots of compassion and love.

We Are Devoted to Our Cats By Peter Soley

With cats, our primary goal is always to find the best forever home for all of our residents, regardless of age or temperament. Sometimes it can take a very long time for the right match. All the staff and volunteers at the S.P.A. are committed to providing a safe and nurturing environment for every animal, regardless of the length of stay. We work hard to create an environment where all cats feel at "home" and where healthy relationships between them can flourish. It's the long-term animal residents who often act in ways large and small to make the S.P.A. so special.

Most of the time, our long-term residents become pillars of their community, helping guide younger cats and promoting harmony. Martín, for example, arrived as a kitten in 2009 and over time has become a seasoned elder, respected by all and messed with by none. He has buddied with many of the younger cats, often protecting them during hostile moments. And now that Martín is experiencing some age-related health problems, it's common to see other cats affectionately head bumping him and standing beside him in fellowship.

Vanderbilt (affectionately called Vandy) arrived as a badly injured and frightened one-year-old in 2017. He healed and soon became so appreciative of the refuge the S.P.A. provides. While still a loner, Vandy is always in the center of the action and usually one of the first to greet volunteers each day. And he knows when to help police bad behavior, helping maintain harmony and building trust among the cats.

Martín and Vandy are two examples of the long-term cat residents the S.P.A. is committed to shelter for however long. They are proof that it's not just the human hands that do all the work. Many of the resident animals also contribute to the success of the S.P.A. And while not all animals may be lucky enough to be adopted, there are some standouts who truly make their S.P.A. community a home to all.







We Are Devoted to Our Dogs By Harry Burrus



-the S.P.A. relies SOLELY on donations to survive-we receive no government support?



The S.P.A.'s clinic is open to the public! The S.P.A. can meet your pet's needs, from routine preventative care to diagnosis and treatment of problems to surgical procedures and more. We have a well-equipped clinic and offer packages to help you save on vaccinations and sterilization. Under the current circumstances, we prefer that no one enters the clinic other than S.P.A. personnel. If critical, only 1 person may enter the S.P.A. with his animal and that person must wear a mask and stay 6 feet (2 meters) away from S.P.A. personnel. Thank you for your consideration in following these rules.

Learn About Us and Our Cats and Dogs

*The S.P.A. is open for adoptions as long as certain precautions are followed. If you come to the S.P.A. with family or friends, only one person will be allowed to enter the S.P.A. to be interviewed for an adoption of a cat or dog. That person must wear a mask and stay at least 6 feet (2 meters) away from S.P.A. personnel. Adoption hours are Monday-Saturday, 11-2.
