

Zander is a beautiful, cat-show-quality tabby. He is also an adorable, curious, and playful cat who loves to be around people.


A gorgeous calico, Ginger relishes chasing the laser pointer light. She is very shy, but allows petting and will play when she doesn't have to compete with others.



The S.P.A. has just welcomed nine new dogs - different sizes, ages, and personalities! Let me tell you about these wonderful dogs.









Baxter




