



For cats, the fee includes sterilization, all current vaccinations, deworming, the feline leukemia/FIV test, and the feline leukemia vaccine and booster. For dogs, it includes sterilization, all current vaccinations, deworming, the leptospirosis booster, and enrollment in the Green Paw Pet Registration Program.

If you come to the S.P.A. with family or friends, only one person will be allowed to enter the S.P.A. to be interviewed for an adoption of a cat or dog. That person must wear a mask and stay at least 6 feet (2 meters) away from S.P.A. personnel. We strongly believe that it is worth the effort to end up with a new loving member of your family to keep you company during these difficult times!

Hats Off to Güera By Megan Gabel



On December 29, 2009, Güera arrived at the S.P.A. Her age was guessed at 2 years old, but we now think she was a couple of years older. She was a love, gazing at you with kind, gentle, and vulnerable eyes. She had a funny habit of running around in circles to get your attention and, when she had it, she started jumping straight up in excitement. She'd happily sit and, if that was not enough, lie down so you could put a leash on her. She eagerly ventured out for a walk at a steady clip, one of our easiest dogs to walk. Sometimes afraid to meet someone new, she was a volunteer favorite, but did not do well on an adoption interview. In fact, she would hide in her tinaco instead of coming out to give people a chance to get to know her and possibly decide to let her become part of their family.

Past tense.

Güera died on April 23, 2020. Eleven years at the S.P.A. For the last few years on a special renal diet due to kidney failure. Never considered by others for adoption. Loved and treasured by S.P.A. volunteers and employees who later joined together to honor her and spread her ashes in the dog exercise area that she played in every day.

When cats and dogs are taken into the S.P.A., they are given the best care and love possible until they are adopted

into their forever families, no matter how long it takes, if at all. Güera exemplifies the S.P.A.'s commitment to the animals we oversee.

A Message from Aussie By Jayn Corral

When a cat or dog is adopted from the S.P.A., we interview potential adopters and then introduce them to available animals. Before adopters leave the S.P.A. with their new pet, we ask the adopters to let us know if there are any problems. A few days later, we always call to check with the new owner to make sure things are going well.



After having been at the S.P.A. for 4 years since he was 5 weeks old, Aussie was adopted in early April by a woman who knew his history, was aware he was very timid and required patience for him to adapt, and agreed to give him a chance. We followed our standard protocol. But no matter what time we called, no one answered. Finally, we found a valid email address and wrote her.

She responded that Aussie had escaped from her home 10 days earlier from an open terrace that she had let him explore. She had not seen him since. She did not look for him, no longer wanted him, and refused to help in the search.

Devastated, I ventured out, located the adopter's street, and, feeling that it was futile, I, nevertheless, started searching. I happened to look up and saw a skinny black and white cat cross

the street and disappear under a garage door. Peeking underneath, I just knew it was Aussie. An old man answered the door and, in Spanish, berated me and told me to leave. Frustrated, I enlisted the help of our bilingual office/clinic coordinator. Even though it was a Sunday, she came quickly and determined the man was angry that the cat had trespassed. He didn't like cats and would not let us in to retrieve Aussie because of the coronavirus.

The next day, after trying a variety of options, we came up with a plan. Scaling a stone wall, our men placed a trap in the nearby vacant lot. They saw Aussie as they were setting the trap, but he ran. We returned later in the day to find our beloved, but angry, Aussie had taken the bait and was in the trap! Back at the S.P.A., he was examined and monitored. He had lost a considerable amount of weight. It was very touching when he joined his former roommates, greeted S.P.A. volunteers, and resumed his daily routines. His cat friends welcomed him back by giving head bumps and body rubs.


Aussie did not know how to survive on his own in the streets of San Miguel. He probably did not have much time left to live. If we had not finally be able to contact the adopter, Aussie would have died.

If you lose a pet, contact the S.P.A. (415-152-6124 or info@spasanmiguel.org), post on Pet SOS Facebook page and other sites, get the word out. Put up posters. Do radio ads. Check Ecologia daily (primarily for dogs).




The Remembrance Tree exists in


