The S.P.A.'s Veterinary Clinic Is Open to the Public! By Megan Gabel

Some people think that the S.P.A.'s veterinary clinic only oversees the care of S.P.A. resident animals like Soleil and Kahlua. That certainly is a primary purpose of our clinic, but we also offer lower-cost, high-quality health care for your pets! The S.P.A.'s on-site clinic (Los Pinos 7) and our full-time veterinarian, Dr. Omar Córdova, are able to meet your pet's needs, from conducting routine exams and providing vaccinations to diagnosing and treating medical issues with your pet, taking x-rays and other tests as needed, performing sterilizations, teeth cleanings, and other surgeries. We also offer packages to reduce the cost of vaccinations and sterilization so all owners can fulfill their responsibilities to take good care of their pets.





At the S.P.A., our cat adoption fee (600 pesos) includes sterilization, all current vaccinations, deworming, and the feline leukemia vaccine and booster. For dogs, the fee (600 pesos) includes sterilization, all current vaccinations, and deworming. Because we want to give pet owners the same opportunity to fully protect their animals, we offer packages for these services at a reduced price. Three packages are available at the S.P.A.: (1) Complete Puppy Package, (2) Complete Kitten Package, and (3) Adult Dog Package, All packages require full payment in advance and expire one year from the payment date. Details about our packages are available on our website on this page: https://www.spasanmiguel.org/clinic-services Each package is available in a downloadable pdf format in Spanish and English.

We offer more ways for you to save on veterinary costs. Tuesdays and Saturdays are discount days at the S.P.A. with lower prices than on other days for consultations and most vaccinations. Our clinic hours are extended from 9-4 on those days and are 9-3, Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. We also give a discount on sterilizations when an S.P.A. pet is adopted and an unsterilized pet is at home. Within two months from the date of adoption, the discount will be given – no limit on the number of pets sterilized and it doesn't matter if you adopt a cat and have an unsterilized dog at home or vice versa or both – the appropriate discount applies.

Please call the S.P.A., 415-152-6124, and make an appointment with Dr. Córdova. We hope you take advantage of the savings we offer.

Cat Litter / Pooper Scooper Not Necessary for Virtual Adoptions! By Megan Gabel

For those of you who love animals, but can't adopt, how about becoming a virtual pet owner? The Adopt Me pages on our website (https://www.spasanmiguel.org/) provide the opportunity to "adopt" cats like Aluxe and dogs like Tessie and bring them virtually into your home.



Aluxe has been an S.P.A. resident for almost 4 years, having arrived when she was only one week old. A beautiful tabby with very pretty markings, she is known as "Tia Aluxe" because she comforts and cares for our newly arriving kittens. She is extraordinarily frightened by loud noises and becomes a professional fighter if anyone tries to pick her up. Once assured that there is no danger, she enjoys petting and attention. She has made the S.P.A. her home and is perfectly content to remain there to carry out her duties as Tia Aluxe. She is a perfect virtual adoption candidate.

Beautiful Tessie has been an S.P.A. resident since May 2013. Medium-sized, she was only 7 months old when she arrived. She likes to go on abbreviated walks, more like sniffing excursions than exercise. She is friendly and affectionate to the people she knows. However, sometimes she snaps at a stranger when she is caught off guard. It could be someone who is trying to pet her without any advance warning. Simply reaching over her head could cause her to snap at the person. So, it is very difficult for us to introduce her to potential adopters. After almost 9 years, it seems that Tessie will likely spend her life at the S.P.A. unless



someone who understands her and can deal with her issues (like a familiar volunteer) decides to actually adopt her.

Virtually adopt (\$20 USD per month) Aluxe, Tessie, or another cat or dog in that program such as Cleo, Sake, Sonny, Martin, Aussie, Taiwan, and more! How can you resist them?

The S.P.A.'s Pet Food Money Bank Fundraiser Begins Now! By Megan Gabel


The Sociedad Protectora de Animales de San Miguel de Allende, A.C., San Miguel's only no-kill shelter for dogs and cats, houses a combined average of 100 animals. We provide food, care (vaccinations, sterilization, medical care), and shelter for all of them until they become family companions—no matter how long it takes. When animals are adopted, we have space to take in more cats and dogs and the cycle continues as we provide all that they need until they, too, are adopted.

The S.P.A.'s annual Pet Food Money Bank fundraiser is our only major fundraiser of the year. Please make a monetary donation to apply to the annual cost of feeding our resident animals like Jett, Vanderbilt, Pammy, and Leo. Because animals do not adjust well to changes in diet and we lack sufficient storage space, we need to raise money to cover the annual cost of feeding our cats and dogs, rather than seek donations of food. We rely solely on financial donations to survive and receive no government support. We economize, but need help covering this basic expense.

The goal of this year's Pet Food Money Bank is \$250,000 pesos (about \$13,500 USD). All funds raised—100%—will be applied to the annual cost of feeding our family-pets-to-be. Some animals are so malnourished or very young when they arrive that we must give them special supplemental food until they become stronger. Sometimes, our animals develop health conditions that require unique diets. These added expenses require us to switch some of our residents from our regular, economy-priced food to other options.






