Thank you for all that you did to help the S.P.A. during 2023. We are pleased to let you know that, thanks to you, we were able to take full advantage of the offer from anonymous donors to match new December donations up to a total of \$2,500! Terrific.

We appreciate and need your continued support during 2024. You make it possible for us to provide food, care, and shelter for an average of 100 animals (combined total of cats and dogs) while they wait to be adopted.

Tuesdays and Thursdays are discount days at the S.P.A.'s clinic. We stay open later (until 4) and the vet's consultation fee plus most vaccinations are reduced on those days.

Our 2024 New Year's Resolution is to provide shelter for as many cats and dogs that we can reasonably handle and find them good and loving homes as quickly as possible. Tres Amigos: Angel, John, and Pammy By Harry Burrus

Throughout history, there have been trios known for unique aspects of their relationship. Threesomes like Snap, Crackle, and Pop, The Three Musketeers, The Kingston Trio, Peter, Paul and Mary, and the Three Tenors, are well known. Add the S.P.A.'s Angel, John, and Pammy to the list of famous trios (with a slightly smaller audience). Angel and John were already a formidable duo. John was always a challenge to get out the door for a walk, but was energized by Angel. Around the same age (close to four), Pammy, had the same hang-ups' as John, so I thought maybe Angel could double her influence to give Pammy courage as well.

Angel is a small/medium-sized girl with de Kooning black and white body markings, a blended tan, black, and white face, and alert, dark eyes. She's comfortable meeting new people. Once on the street, she moves at a good clip until an alluring smell momentarily sidetracks her and she pauses to investigate. She will toss a lookout bark at street dogs, alerting them she's not a girl to mess with.

John is medium-sized, with a muted caramel, amber-colored coat, with a creamy white chest and white inner thighs. He has striking gold eyes outlined with pharaoh-kohl contouring. A good-looking lad. At first, John is wary of new people. He's nervous and cautious. You have to earn his trust, which can take a while. His surprisingly friendly demeaner is a pleasant surprise. However, while all that is good, John is afraid of the street. Loud noises, fireworks, cars rushing past, deter him from going for a walk. If he makes it out of the S.P.A. door, you're generally good to go. He may walk up to the street door, even poke his head out, but that's it. Mr. Reluctance.

Pammy, a beauty with burnt orange, brown swirl coloring, possesses a high nervous energy demeanor. For long periods, she'd remain in her tinaco if a volunteer sat in her casita. After you sit with her multiple times, if you are lucky, she rewards you by coming close, revealing a surprisingly friendly demeaner, sometimes, generous with kisses.

I and two other volunteers approach their casitas. We're uniformly greeted with enthusiasm. Once we have saddled up the Tres Amigos with harnesses, the posse is ready to capture the street. Getting out the S.P.A. door to the street for John is the first challenge. If cars whizz past or a handful of people walk by, John balks. Refuses to move forward. Sometimes, he's stubbornly indisposed to step outside, even if the street is clear. A few encouraging words (or a lot), and generous friendly tugging will move the reluctant troubadour forward.

Out the door, we take on the street. The formation varies. Early on, Angel was out in front, followed by Pammy and then John. As is often the case, a female steps in to provide leadership. Pammy eagerly follows Angel and John stays close to the wall as cars whizz past. It's fun watching the dynamics alter. Somedays, Pammy chooses to ride point, moving quickly. When John slows or stops, I pull a reverse Hansel and drop treats behind me, which gets John moving as he hurries to pick them up. This continues for some distance. We all get a kick out of seeing the shy Pammy out front, establishing a rapid pace. Twice, John has stepped up his game and has surged forward. Today, Pammy and John established a fierce pace all the way to our turnaround point—a spot we call "the treat seat," just before an abandoned flat-tired ancient VW. We give the trio the expectant treats and head back, our return a surprisingly relaxed pace. It's a kick for all of us to see the three dogs enjoying the walk. As we unleash them in their casitas, we praise them for conquering the street.



Under the current circumstances, we prefer that no one enters the clinic other than S.P.A. personnel. If critical, only 1 person may enter the S.P.A. with his animal and that person must wear a mask and stay 6 feet (2 meters) away from S.P.A. personnel. Thank you for your consideration in following these rules.
